Are you a high school senior or transfer student? With the WSU admissions priority deadline just a few days away, I strongly advise students to submit their applications for admission and scholarships by Jan 31st. Students who apply for admissions by January 31 will be given priority for acceptance. Applications for the WSU Academic Scholarship pool will not be considered after January 31. Don't miss out on your chance of being considered for over 700+ scholarships!

- Jan. 31, 2013 -- Deadline for [WSU Academic Scholarship](#)

Grades, talent, financial need, leadership, ambition — any one of these could get you a scholarship. Fill out one scholarship application to be put in a pool for over 700 scholarships. Good luck!

- Registration Is Now Open for [Future Cougars of Color](#)

Future Cougars of Color (FCOC) is a scholarship and visitation program for newly-admitted Cougs. You must have completed the WSU admission and scholarship applications by Jan 31, and be offered in-state* admission, to qualify for FCOC. All students who attend the March 22-23, 2013 FCOC weekend will receive a renewable scholarship ranging from \$1000-\$5000 per year!

*Students who qualify for in-state tuition under the [American Indian Residency Bill](#) are eligible to attend.

- Jan 31, 2013 – Deadline to apply for [College Assistance Migrant Program](#)

The College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) provides assistance for eligible students from migrant and/or seasonal farmworker backgrounds by recruiting them into higher education and providing them with academic support services – including workshops, free tutoring, and a stipend – to ensure successful completion of their freshman year in college.

- Feb 1, 2013 – Deadline to apply for [First Scholars Program](#)

Know a high school senior who will be a first-generation WSU student in the fall? Encourage them to check out the First Scholars Program! First Scholars provides recipients with 4 years of support and programming along with a \$20,000.00 scholarship! Deadline is February 1, 2013!

- Feb 15, 2013 – [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) Priority Deadline

I encourage you to submit your FAFSA before the WSU Financial Aid Office's priority deadline of Feb 15th. If you haven't done your taxes yet, estimate your financial information. You are allowed to go back and make corrections after you've filed your taxes. You don't want to miss the February 15th deadline, because the earlier you file your FAFSA, the more options for aid you will have. Missing the deadline can make a big difference in your financial aid package.

Keep in mind that your FAFSA will be used for the entire academic year. So, for example, the 2013–2014 FAFSA is used for Fall 2013, Spring 2014, and Summer 2014.

There are many websites out there that will charge a fee to submit a FAFSA. DO NOT PAY. Here is the link to submit your FAFSA for free: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>
