WSU students and community have the opportunity to watch “Winter in the Blood” free of charge, on Feb. 25th at 7 p.m. in the CUB Auditorium.

In attendance for the movie showing will be one of the directors of the film, Alex Smith, who will be providing an opening address for the movie and host a discussion following the movie.

“Winter in the Blood” became an official selection of the Los Angeles Film Festival and Austin Film Festival in 2013 and received outstanding reviews from accomplished critics.

The film, based on the novel by Blackfeet author James Welch, follows Virgil First Raised, played by Chaske Spencer. Virgil awakens one day to find his wife gone and his prized rifle missing and sets out on a journey to find the two. While on his odyssey he is forced to look inside himself and come to terms with some painful memories.

Lead actor, Spencer, is a member of the Lakota Sioux tribe and grew up in part on the Nez Perce reservation in Idaho. He is best known for playing the werewolf “Sam” in the Twilight films.
