I'm really excited to see WSU Organic Compost getting delivered to the farm today! This has been a LONG time coming. Just last week the WSU Compost Facility received approval to list WSU Organic Compost as a certified organic material through the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA).

The farm stopped using WSU Compost many years ago after it discovered to have a couple ingredients that were not allowed in organic production. Over the last two years, Rick Finch, Lynne Carpenter-Boggs, and undergraduate Organic Ag major, Emily Barber, worked to develop a mix at the compost

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facility that could be approved for use in certified organic farms.

We will be getting this freshly delivered nutrient rich material spread in the hoopouses in preparation for the winter spinach seeding this week. And then, on to the fields as crops are quickly coming out during harvest.
