Photography Workshop This Saturday

Saturday, January 21st, at 12:00 Noon in the Cougar Auditorium at the WSU Extension Office, there will be a workshop on Digital Editing of photographs. Steve will give a presentation and then we will transition into the computer lab and 4-H members will be able to try the software on their own and make their own edits based on what they learned in the presentation. We plan to be at the extension office until 3:00 PM, so as time permits, feel free to also work on digital photos of your own. Bring some on a USB chip to the workshop.

This workshop will qualify you for Evergreen State Fair, and because of the scientific nature of what we will be doing, the workshop will also provide one of four qualifiers for the STEM Patch in Photography for 2017.

4-H Challenge Course Training

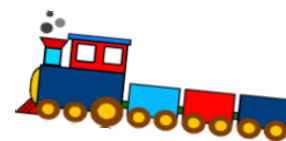
