Engineering Life Sciences building opens for classes soon



The Engineering Life Sciences building houses 3 new classrooms, 24 offices and 21 labs including microscopy, computer aided design (CAD), clean room, robotics, molecular/microbiology physiology and Earth sciences.

The 61,000 square foot Engineering Life Sciences building opens for classes January 16 and will be formally dedicated in the presence of WSU President V. Lane Rawlins, the WSU Board of Regents, community members and business leaders January 25.

It is the newest, largest and most state-of-the-art addition to campus and supports the Bachelor of Science in Manufacturing Engineering, the Master's in Engineering Management, the Bachelor of Arts in Computer Science and the Bachelor of Science in Biology.

Located on the north-end of campus, the building houses dedicated engineering and science labs, computer labs, general classrooms, offices and a greenhouse with six individual climate-controlled stations.

Planning and design on the building began in 1996 and initial construction began in 1999. Gifts made by Hewlett Packard, SEH America, the Society of Manufacturing Engineers Education Foundation, Tektronix, Inc., the National Science Foundation and the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust support the facility's learning and research labs.

- ◆ Construction on the Firstenberg Family Fountain is complete and equipment is being tested. A formal dedication of the fountain will take place in January.
- ◆ The new entry road from 50th Ave. has reached substantial completion. It is scheduled to open after all construction is completed later this month. Equipped with locking gates, the roadway will close daily during late evening-early morning hours.

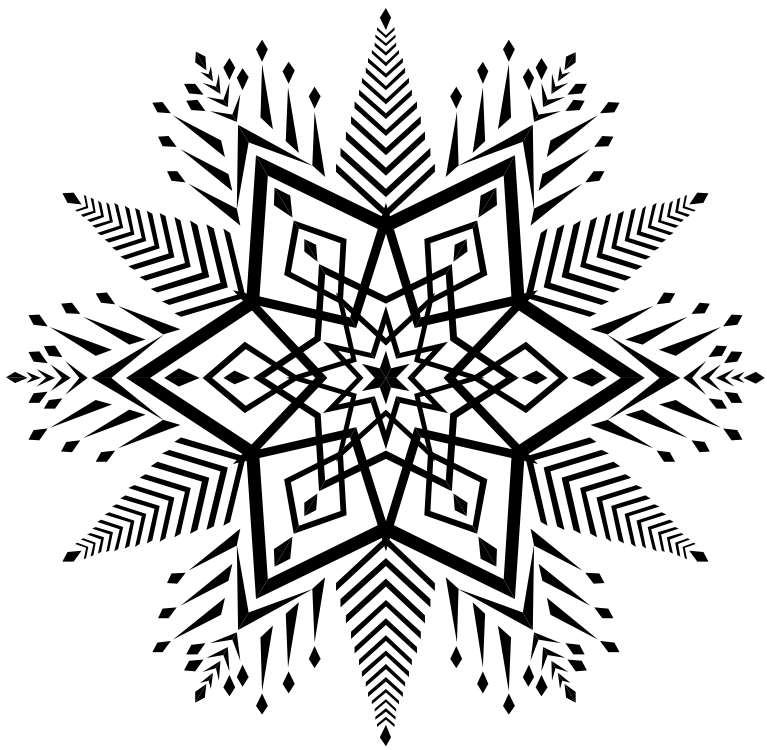
