The title page of the dissertation gives the date of 1967, but this is in error. I submitted the final typed copy with a 1967 date because I thought I had missed the deadline for a December, 1966 graduation, but in fact my dissertation chair, Irving B. Rouse, prevailed upon the Graduate School to let me graduate in December. So my diploma is actually dated "IV ID. DEC. ANNO DOMINI MDCCCCLXVI" (remember, it's a Yale diploma...).

No one, including me, thought to change the date on the title page of the dissertation, so it was submitted to the library that way. I was teaching at SUNY-Binghamton at the time, and not tracking on what was going on in New Haven. In any case, the 1967 date stayed on the title page when it was reproduced by University Microfilms (now UMI), and the dissertation is still listed with that date in the UMI database.
